LOFT RULES for 2024

1. Entry fee

- N\$ 1200.00 per bird no limit on entries
- This entry amount gives the entrant the right to compete for the total prize money available as laid out in these rules.
- The entrant relinquishes his ownership of his bird/s to the WRDK National Loft.

2. Payment Schedule

- A 50% deposit per entered pigeon must be paid on or before 30 November 2023 and the remainder not later than 31st March 2024.
- Birds not paid for in full by 31st March 2024 will be returned to the entrant or withdrawn from the loft and disposed of as management see fit.

3. Exchange rate

• Entry fees and prize moneys are calculated according to the N\$ exchange rate at the date of payment.

4. Transport to the Loft

 The entrant is responsible for his own transport arrangements and cost thereof. This is also applied to overseas entrants. Should International entries require a mandatory quarantine period from the veterinary services of Namibia the cost would be for his account.

5. Ring date

• Pigeons entered should be rung with officially recognized 2023 life rings.

6. Indemnity

 The WRDK National Loft is indemnified against any claims due to injuries, death, or loss of any pigeons during the care, training and racing of the pigeons.

7. Visitation rights

Any person visiting the loft premises will do it on his own risk and will
not be able to claim for any loss, damage or injuries against the loft
or the loft management.

8. Loft access

 No person(s) will be allowed in the loft without management's authorization.

9. Ownership

 Pigeons entered in the loft become the property of the loft and will be managed and disposed of at the sole discretion of the loft management.

10. Lost birds

 A perch fee will apply to birds lost during the homing and relocation period up until the final count before the first race. The fee applicable would-be N\$ 700.00 per lost bird.

11. Refunds

• No entry fees will be refunded.

12. Prize money

- Prizes as advertised are guaranteed on condition that the loft receive 300 paid entries.
- If entries are less the prize money will be adjusted accordingly.
- Prizes are as follows: see paragraph 23

13. Prize giving

- All prize money including auction proceeds will be credited to the entrants account with the WRDK National Loft.
- Credits will be paid out to the entrant on written request to do so to the management.

14. Intake for 2024

• The loft open on the 1st of September 2023 for entries and closes on 30th of November 2023, no birds will be accepted later than this date.

15. Race reports, Basketing lists and Rollcall readouts

- Management will issue reports of training flights and the races.

16. Auctions

- The first 40 birds returning on the final together with the top 10 ace birds will be put on auction within 7 days from the final. Total 40 birds plus additional ace birds.
- The proceeds from the auction will be shared in equal parts between the national loft and the entrant of the bird.
- For the entrant to qualify for his 50% of the proceeds a pedigree of the bird entered must reach the loft management before the first hotspot of the season.

17. Birds not sold

 Birds not sold on the auction will be sold out of hand for the loft owners account only or returned to the entrant as the loft management deemed fit.

18. Management

 Resolutions and decisions by loft management is final and binding on all entrants to the loft, no correspondence on resolutions and decisions will negotiable.

19. Races

- The race program consists out of the following program
 - 4 Hotspots 290km, 380km, 450 KM, 500km
 - 1 Final 580km
 - 4 Sprint races for a maximum distance of 230 kilometers

20. Race conditions

- Weather permits all races will take place on Saturdays.
- Training at the sole discretion of the loft manager

21. Clocking devices

- If the clocking device fail for whatever reason and it is impossible
 to confirm arrival times the result will become null and void,
 management will decide on any further action to be taken.
- Order of arrival as printed on the clocking list determine the positions flown by individual birds. It is emphasized that the clocking list as printed via the club master system is the only accepted official record of the race.
- Birds clocked at the same time on the ets position is determined by the clocking list printed by the ets. If the time of arrival needs to be adjusted to accommodate the order of arrival of the birds as printed on the clocking list the race secretary is allowed to do so.
